

## Larimer County Fairgrounds and Events Complex



**The Ranch** is located directly adjacent to I-25, just North of Highway 34, in Loveland, Colorado. To reach The Ranch, **use I-25 exit 262 (Windsor Exit) and go back east to Fairgrounds Ave and then south and enter the fairgrounds through north entrance.** There is a HUGE Jehovah's Witness convention that same weekend and they will all be using exit 259, and that exit should be avoided if at all possible.

### FOR OPEN/ALL-BREED DIVISION ONLY:

1. MHBHA reserves the right to combine Open classes with 3 or less entries, or split larger classes. There shall be no refunds once a class has been entered. If there is only one horse entered, and that class runs, there will be no refund if the exhibitor decides to scratch.
2. High Points are based on one horse/one rider combination.
3. AHSA rules apply.

### FOR IBHA/BUCKSKIN DIVISION ONLY:

1. All horses entering IBHA/MHBHA classes must be registered with the INTERNATIONAL BUCKSKIN HORSE ASSOCIATION and present papers at time of entry. Horses two years of age and older must have a T-tentative or P-permanent letter before their registration number to be eligible to show.
2. Any youth or amateur wishing to show in approved IBHA youth/amateur classes must have a current year Youth/Amateur membership card from IBHA to present at the show. Open classes require an Open membership card from IBHA. Amateur, Youth and Open IBHA memberships may be purchased at a show, with a rush fee.
3. Daily High Points at MHBHA shows will be figured in the following manner on MHBHA point system:
  - High point IBHA Youth - points are based on youth-one horse/rider
  - High point IBHA Amateur - points are based on amateur -one horse/rider
  - High point IBHA Open - points are based on horse, no limit on exhibitors – only one color class (the highest pointed one) counts towards high point.
4. IBHA rules apply.

### General Show Information

1. A signed check must be left with open tabs at the time entries are made at the office.
2. Horses shall be excused if unruly or dangerous.
3. Exhibitors shall be dismissed for exhibiting cruelty to or abuse of any horse.
4. Dogs are discouraged at shows and must be kept on leash at all times per insurance and safety requirements.
5. Sportsmanlike conduct toward judges, exhibitors and spectators is expected and required at all times.
6. No materials may be handed out at any MHBHA show which are not approved in advance.
7. Membership applications with payment for Mile Hi Buckskin Horse Association will be accepted at the shows. However, all memberships must be approved by the Board at the next Board meeting. Points will be awarded for the show where membership was received, retroactively upon membership approval.
8. Exhibitors adding classes should do so at least 3 classes prior.
9. MHBHA is not responsible for accident or lost or stolen property.
10. A 3-minute gate hold may be requested for tack or rider changes.
11. Judges decisions are final.
12. IBHA exhibitors are required to know their breed rules.
13. There shall be no refunds once a class has been entered.
14. If there is only one horse entered, and that class runs, there will be no refund if the exhibitor decides to scratch.
15. Entries (horse/rider combo) in walk/trot classes may not enter any other class requiring a lope or canter.
